Treasurer Report – Patty was unable to attend but sent the financial report for the March agility trial co hosted with PAC. Net profit to the club was \$2000.

Trailer:

Motion: To purchase a 16 ft trailer at Trailers Plus in Salem for under \$4000. Passed.

Don will look at the trailer tomorrow and if it is as advertised (on sale for 3 more days) then he will leave a deposit.

Lifetime Memberships:

Membership terms were reviewed and it was determined that Jim Barnhart, Sally Hathaway and Kay Reamensnyder all qualify for lifetime membership at this time.

A certificate of Lifetime Membership will be created and presented to them at the general membership meeting.

Show: Karen needs volunteers to help at the show – specifically someone to take care of judge hospitality and lunches. Lunches will again be fried chicken and salads.

Fun Match: Randy is trying to determine a date for the match which will include conformation and show n' go obedience. The park in Orchards is free but we would have to have someone there bright and early to start set-up.

Agility Ring Crews: Connie stated she would contact groups to find ring crews.

Motion: Betty, 2<sup>nd</sup> Don – To authorize \$200-\$250 per day for ring crews. This means 4 persons per ring for 6 hours. The price is equal if not less than providing lunches for numerous exhibitor-volunteers who work only part of a class. PASSED

Nominations for 2011 shows. Nominations will be taken in May and June. Karen will then verify availability. The vote will be taken in July. Names may be presented at the meeting or emailed to Karen for verification.

The show chair or her designee will be the only person designated to contact the judges and they may not exhibit. Any other club member contacting potential judges about the assignment after they are nominated may not exhibit under that judge.

Canine Experience: June 19, 2010, Washington County Fair Complex.

Participation in this event meets most of our AKC club requirements. To get credit we must provide volunteers to provide 2 hours of labor – set up, tear down or registration.
